What You Treasure Is What You Get

Hebrews 10:26-39

²⁶ For if we go on sinning deliberately after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, ²⁷ but a fearful expectation of judgment, and a fury of fire that will consume the adversaries. ²⁸ Anyone who has set aside the law of Moses dies without mercy on the evidence of two or three witnesses. ²⁹ How much worse punishment, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has trampled underfoot the Son of God, and has profaned the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has outraged the Spirit of grace? ³⁰ For we know him who said, “Vengeance is mine; I will repay.” And again, “The Lord will judge his people.” ³¹ It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

³² But recall the former days when, after you were enlightened, you endured a hard struggle with sufferings, ³³ sometimes being publicly exposed to reproach and affliction, and sometimes being partners with those so treated. ³⁴ For you had compassion on those in prison, and you joyfully accepted the plundering of your property, since you knew that you yourselves had a better possession and an abiding one. ³⁵ Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward.

³⁶ For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. ³⁷ For,

“Yet a little while,
and the coming one will come and will not delay;
³⁸ but my righteous one shall live by faith,
and if he shrinks back,
my soul has no pleasure in him.”

³⁹ But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls.

Main Idea: Whatever you treasure most is exactly what you will get in the end.

I. Warning: If you don't treasure Jesus, you will spend eternity away from Him.

II. Promise: If you treasure Jesus, you will get him for all eternity and more.

The Lord's Supper

Minister: We proclaim our faith as signed and sealed in this sacrament.

People: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.

Minister: Praise you, Lord Jesus.

People: Dying, you destroyed our death. Rising, you restored our life. Lord Jesus, come in glory.

Minister: We profess our union with Christ in his life, death, and resurrection. We offer our thanks while we yearn for the coming marriage supper of the Lamb.

People: When we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim your death, Lord Jesus, until you come in glory.
