³⁰ By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they had been encircled for seven days. ³¹ By faith Rahab the prostitute did not perish with those who were disobedient, because she had given a friendly welcome to the spies.

³² And what more shall I say? For time would fail me to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets— ³³ who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, ³⁴ quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, were made strong out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. ³⁵ Women received back their dead by resurrection. Some were tortured, refusing to accept release, so that they might rise again to a better life. ³⁶ Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment. ³⁷ They were stoned, they were sawn in two, they were killed with the sword. They went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, afflicted, mistreated— ³⁸ of whom the world was not worthy— wandering about in deserts and mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.

³⁹ And all these, though commended through their faith, did not receive what was promised, ⁴⁰ since God had provided something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect.

OUTREACH PRAYER FOCUS — Center for Church Planting - Centro Para La Plantación De Iglesias (CPI)

CPI, working with other partners, reached their goal of planting 10 new church plants in 10 cities by 2024. Their new goal is to establish 10 church networks in Northern Mexico by 2030! Please pray for CPI and their church plants:

- Praise for the growth that the La Paz church plant and Pastor Benjamin and wife Blanca have seen. Pray that the Lord would bring a music minister, musicians, and youth teachers to the church. Pray that they will be able to organize as a church and be particularized in 2027!
- Pray for the church plants in Hermosillo and Chihuahua will find new locations for Sunday worship.
- Pray for church planter Marcos Valera in Cuilcan, for his protection and health, for his mission to share the gospel in a dangerous environment, and that God would open doors for many to come to Him.
- Pray that the Lord will give CPI greater opportunities for mercy and justice ministries in Mexico. The Gospel is the only answer to the violence, persecution, and poverty in Mexico.
- Pray that the Lord would graciously provide the resources needed by CPI and their church plants. Pray for their financial resources as they are losing money each month due to the low exchange rate of pesos to dollars.
